

WHEEL CUTTER

SAFE OPERATING PROCEDURE

Do not use this equipment unless you have been properly trained and instructed in its safe use and have been given prior permission.





PRE-OPERATIONAL SAFETY CHECKS:

- 1. Ensure the worktable is clean and clear of fabric offcuts and tools.
- 2. Ensure the workspace is clear of trip and slip hazards.
- 3. Ensure the matt, ruler and cutter are in good safe working order.
- 4. Check all safety features before commencing any cutting operation.
- 5. Ensure the cutting mat is safely positioned on the work bench at an appropriate height.
- 6. Ensure the blade is in good working order.
- 7. Never use a metal or timber ruler when making a cut with a wheel cutter, these rulers can damage the blade of the cutter. Use a specifically designed plastic ruler.

OPERATIONAL SAFETY CHECKS:

- 1. Ensure that the fabric rests flat on the cutting mat.
- 2. Operate the wheel cutter cautiously, keep fingers and hands well clear of the path of the blade.

HOUSE KEEPING

- 1. Once work is complete, ensure the safety features are locked into place.
- 2. Store safely in the appropriate storage location.
- 3. Do not wear loose clothing, especially long sleeves.
- 4. Never leave the wheel cutter unattended without the safety features in place.

POTENTIAL HAZARDS

- Dropping the wheel cutter onto feet: ensure you are wearing the appropriate protective footwear
- Back injuries due to poorly placed equipment and bad working posture.
- Hand injuries.
